Feature film "EDISON" on queue to star Justin Timberlake, Kevin Spacey, Morgan Freeman and LL Cool J in Vancouver, BC this March

(Vancouver B.C) – Millennium Films is queued up to shoot the feature film "Edison" this spring in the Greater Vancouver area. The production brings to town a high profile cast including Kevin Spacey, Morgan Freeman, LL Cool J and the recently much talked about Justin Timberlake in his dramatic screen debut. The film follows Timberlake as a young journalist who uncovers the inner workings of a corrupt police unit. At the point of no return, he allies with his mentor (Freeman), the D.A.'s top investigator (Spacey) and a conscientious police officer (LL Cool J) and leads us on a haunting spiral full of surprises.

David Burke, best known for "Wiseguy" and "Law and Order: Special Victims Unit" will direct the film based on his own original screenplay. John Thompson and Randall Emmett will produce with Millennium's Avi Lerner and Boaz Davidson on board as Executive Producers.

John Thompson, producer with Millennium Films adds, "Edison is an exciting project with an excellent cast. The city of Vancouver offers the perfect setting for our story to unfold and we're all very happy to be filming here."

Vancouver's Brightlight Pictures will be producing the film for Millennium under the supervision of co-founder and principal Shawn Williamson.

Recent productions include "Mozart and the Whale" currently shooting in Spokane, Washington, starring Josh Hartnett and Radha Mitchell with director Petter Naess; "Loverboy" starring Sandra Bullock, Marisa Tomei, Matt Dillon, Oliver Platt, Kyra Sedgewick, and director and star, Kevin Bacon; "Control" starring Ray Liotta, Willem Dafoe, Michelle Rodriguez with director Tim Hunter; and "Blind Horizon", slated to be released in April 2004, starring Val Kilmer, Neve Campbell, Sam Shepard with director Michael Hausman.
